Saturday 12 June: Private Flight from Brisbane to Birdsville and Lake Eyre return

At 6.30am we check-in at Brisbane Jetbase (via Dryandra Road) for boarding your Skytrans flight for an incredible day out. Free street parking is available at Brisbane Jetbase. At 7.30am we take-off viewing the cotton and grain fields around Dalby and watch as the landscape gradually changes to the red mulga country near Charleville. Continue west to Birdsville where you land and pick up your Bush Poet and Guide, John Major. After a short fuel stop at Birdsville it's time to head to Lake Eyre viewing the Channel Country, the Simpson Desert, and Goyder Lagoon on the way. Witness an amazing display of watery veins branching out over this harsh environment and marvel at the large water systems of the Cooper Creek and the Diamantina River. We spend 2 hours flying over the salt lake, while John Major provides you with facts and entertainment as you view the stunning landscape below. At 2.00pm we return to Birdsville where you have the opportunity to visit the historic Birdsville Hotel, enjoy a refreshing complimentary beverage and have a brief look around town. At 3.00pm we depart Birdsville enroute to Brisbane, arriving into Brisbane Jetbase at approximately 6.30pm.
